Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to your online application No. **EX-01877-1718** registered or **29.06.2016**, on the above subject.

In this connection, I am directed to convey the sanction for extension of provisional affiliation of the school with the Board for its <u>Secondary School Examination and Senior School Certificate Examination</u> for a further period of five years w.e.f. 01.04.2017 to 31.03.2022 subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- 1. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.
- The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires as per Rule 15.11 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 3. The school must follow Uniform System of Assessment, Examination and Report Carc for classes VI IX from Academic Year 2017-18 onwards as per Board's Circular no. Acad-14/2017 dated 21/03/2017.
- The school must submit it's information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per the Board's Circular no. CBSE/Aff./4/Circular/2016 dated 10/11/2016 within 30 days from the receipt of this grant letter. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in.
- The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondar School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
- 6. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt from time to time.
- 7. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school a prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under *from Pre-Primary to Class XII*:-

8. The school should scrupulously observe prescription from the Municipal Authority/Dist Collectorate/Transport Department regarding drinking water, fire safety and transp precautions in the school. A certificate from the Municipal/Fire/transport Authority regard sanitary conditions, water/fire/transport safety should be submitted every five years as I Rule 8.5 of Affiliation Bye Laws and shall follow Rule no. 3.3(vii) and Rule 23(xi) in this rega

9. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms the Board. The relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in I library and would keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 boc excluding text books.

10. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the Str Government concerned.

11. As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than students.

12. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software alc with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from a service provider to be ensured.

13. The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions

Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.

14. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and t school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.

15. Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Charter Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year

16. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Educati of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. No capitation fee or volunta donations for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charge collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or t parents or guardians to any screening procedure in accordance with Rule No. 11.1, 2 & Also, as per Chapter II, Rule No. 11.1 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, fees charges should commensurate with the facilities provided by the institution.

17. The school should not engage in commercialization activities:-

18. As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any sha whatsoever.

19. As per rule no. 19.1 (ii).a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of nε motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be ter as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.

20. Teachers are to be made educated regarding corporal punishment& should avoid any type

such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).

21. School will not prepare any student/ start class for any other Board except CBSE from CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.

22. Admission to the school is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye

and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.

The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from sexual harassme the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supr Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajas and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.

- 24. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame Service Rules fo employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoptic the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Fur Service contract will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Educa Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Educa Act.
- 25. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to \$ Government/Govt. of India. Further, Salary and Service conditions of staff should provided in accordance with Rule no. 3.3 (v) and Rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-

a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as

Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.

b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of

appointment of the teachers on probation.

26. As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by Board/State/ Central Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given fo furnishing to the authority concerned and the school should prepare its annual recontaining comprehensive information including name, postal address and e-mail, teleph numbers, affiliation status, period of provisional affiliation, details of infrastructures, detail teachers, number of students and status of fulfillment of norms of affiliation Bye-Laws upload the same on the website before 15th September of every year. As per rule no. 8.8 v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of stude postal address and e-mail, telephone number etc.

Continuous sponsoring of students at Board examination is to be made as per rule 1 (iv), Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school

Secondary and Senior Secondary Examination as the case may be.

As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates when not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any Board's Examinations

29. Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providin coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict actio would be taken on defaulters.

30. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequated provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.

31. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board an evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.

32. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institut recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.

33. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.

34. Strict adherence to the provisions of **Wild Life Protection Act** while procuring plants an animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 2 May 2013

35. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTE State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordan with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

37. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated w the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as nominee in the School Managing Committee (Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV).

38. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.

39. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBS schools.

40. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one socie Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed a the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.

41. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose a also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in&www.cbse.nic.in for updates.

42. In case of established violation of the provisions contained in Affiliation/Examination Bye of the Board, the school shall be liable for disaffiliation as per Rule No. 17 of Affiliation laws.

- 43. The school shall enter into an agreement with the Board detailing the terms and conditions for grant of affiliation, which will be binding on both the parties.
- 44. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-
 - (a) The school is required to reconstitute the School Managing Committee as per the provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board and also include two Board's nominees in it. In this regard a panel of five Principals (inclusive of at least 2-3 Principals from nearby JNV/KV) be forwarded.
 - (b) The school is having untrained teachers whereas the school is required to appoint teachers (on permanent basis instead of adhoc) who are trained and qualified as per provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board to maintain section teacher ratio i.e. 1.5 teachers per section at each level. Also, the school is required to ensure that no staff member may be appointed/continued in the services of the school who has attained the age of superannuation. Hence, a copy of revised staff statement is required to be submitted showing Name, Qualification, Designation, Date of Appointment, Date of Confirmation, classes assigned experience etc. after doing needful.
 - (c) The school is required to pay the pay scale and allowances which should at least be at par with corresponding categories of teachers employed in government institutions of the State Govt. or as per scale prescribed in 6th Central Pay Commission of Govt. of India in respect of its teachers and will make the payment through ECS mode with proper deduction of EPF and other facilities as per norms of the Board. An evidence to this effect, a copy of acquittance roll for the last 03 months alongwith Banker Certificate are required to be submitted in support of it. The same can be checked and verified by the Board at any time.
 - (d) The school library needs to be enriched with more books and periodicals etc.
 - (e) The school is required to maintain the reserve funds in the joint names of Manager of the school concerned and Secretary, CBSE of the Board as per norms under clause xxiii of Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board and furnish a copy of the same.
